

MULHOLLAND MIDDLE SCHOOL MAGNETS CELL PHONE/ELECTRONIC DEVICE POLICY

Possession of a cellular telephone by a student is a privilege, which may be forfeited by any student who fails to abide by the terms and conditions of this policy.

A student may possess a cellular telephone in school, on school property, at after school activities, and at school related events, provided that during school hours [8-3:30] AND in the school buildings, the cell phone must remain off and concealed, unless permission is given.

Violations of this policy will result in the confiscation of the phone and/or loss of privilege to carry one. Confiscated cell phones/electronic devices can be picked up by the parent/guardian during the afterschool hours of 3:30-4:30pm. The student who possesses a cell phone assumes responsibility for its care. At no time shall LAUSD, Mulholland staff or parent volunteers be responsible for preventing theft, loss or damage to cell phones/electronic devices brought onto school property or kept in school provided lockers.

The Los Angeles School Police Department and the Los Angeles Unified School District strongly encourage students to leave their personal electronic equipment at home. Mulholland Middle School and Magnets will not be responsible for theft or loss of items of this nature brought to school or kept in lockers.
