LAPL gives all students in LAUSD a Student Success Card. If you have your card or a regular library card, you are able to check out ebooks already.

If you do not have your Student Success Card, you can apply for an instant e-Card. After receiving an e-card you will need to complete a postcard verifying your address in a couple weeks to maintain access.
